Slow waltz through the statute

Copyright protection subsists  
... in original works of authorship

102(a) FIXED in any tangible medium of expression . . .

- A [now known]...
- B [perceived etc.]
- C [machine/device]

The owner of copyright under this title has the exclusive right to . . .

106 (1) to reproduce the copyrighted works in COPIES or PHONORECORDS

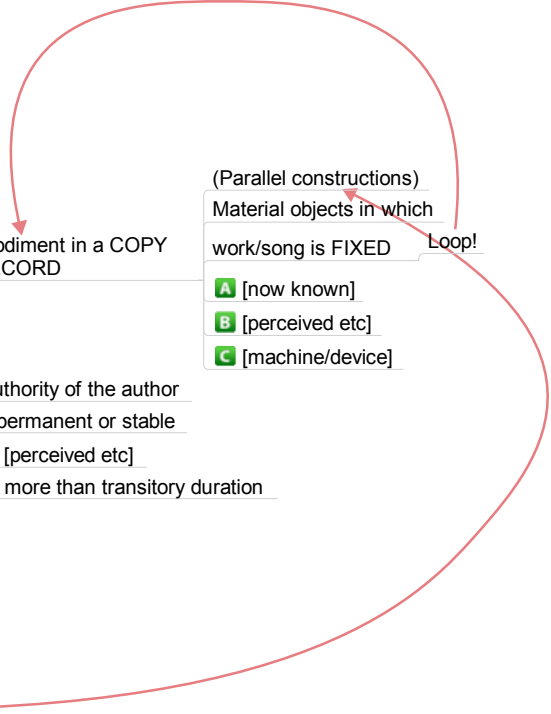
when its embodiment in a COPY or PHONORECORD

by or under authority of the author is sufficiently permanent or stable  
B to permit it [perceived etc]  
for a period of more than transitory duration

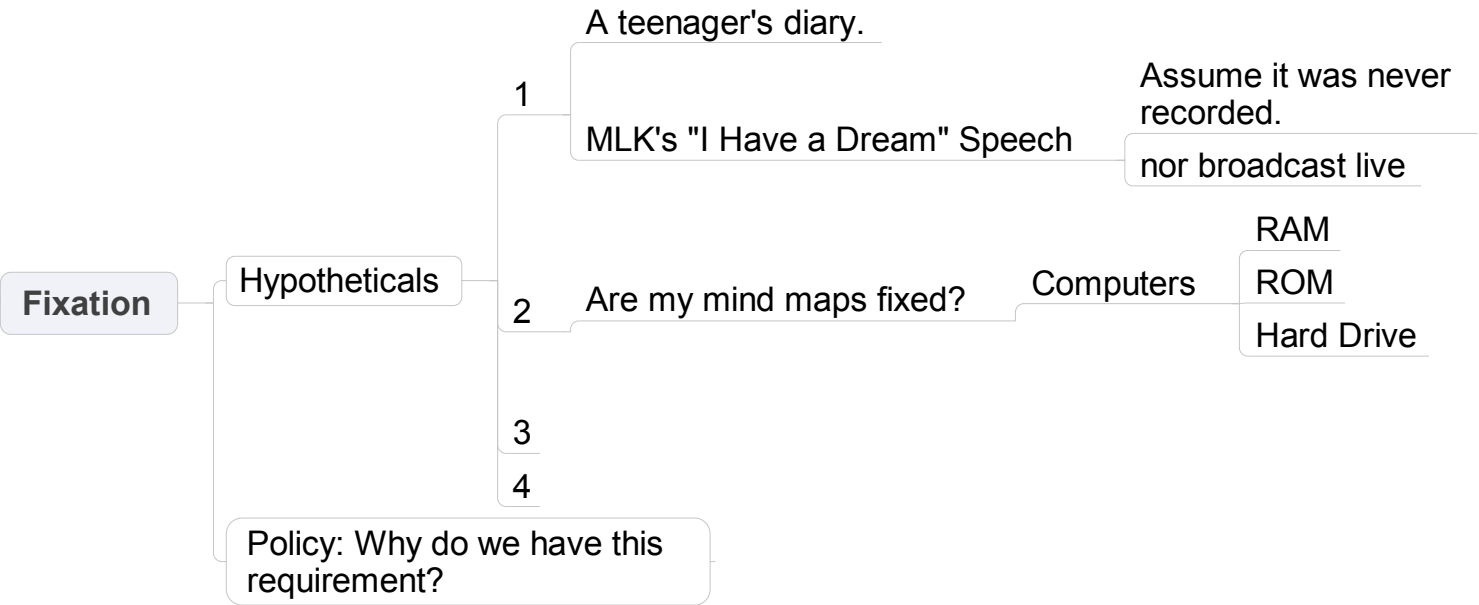
(Parallel constructions)  
Material objects in which work/song is FIXED
